TOPIC: Sturgeon Setline Fishery

ACTION REQUESTED: Close the late Fall Sturgeon Setline Fishery in the Bonneville Pool.

FORMAL ACTION TAKEN: As of October 20 a total of 33 harvestable Sturgeon remain available for treaty commercial harvest in the Bonneville Pool of the Columbia River. These fish are projected to be caught before the scheduled close of the sturgeon setline fishery on October 31, 2011. Therefore, the FWLO Committee closes the sturgeon setline fishery and the sale of sturgeon in the Bonneville Pool at 6 p.m. October 24, 2011. Sturgeon between 38-inches and 60-inches in Forklength may be kept for subsistence in the Bonneville Pool. Any sturgeon caught legally before the close of the sale maybe sold after the closure. The setline fishery in The Dalles and John Day Pools remains open as previously scheduled. Regulations are pursuant to Title 32.14 of the Revised Law & Order Code of the Yakama Nation. Authority to enforce these regulations is provided under Section 32.18.07 of the Code. Violations of any of these regulations are punishable under Section 32.18.07 of the Code.
